## 05 Changes in Legally Obligated Child Support – Standard Reporting

For NA, changes in legally obligated <u>court-ordered child support</u> must be reported. Changes that must be reported include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Changes of more than \$50 in the monthly amount of legally obligated child support actually paid.
- When the child reaches an age where child support is no longer legally obligated.

A change may be reported or discovered in the child support order or the participant may stop paying the child support. When this occurs, effect the change in the deduction amount allowing for <u>NOAA</u>. The change must be completed by the next approval period.
