.02 Effecting Multiple Changes- Standard Reporting

When two or more changes occur and are reported on the same change report, determine the net effect of all changes.

WARNING

A participant CANNOT be added unless their income and resources, when applicable, are included.

When the net effect of multiple changes results in a benefit decrease and does not allow for <u>NOAA</u>, treat the changes individually as follows:

- Effect changes that result in a benefit increase for the following month. (When adding a new participant, see <u>Causes an</u> <u>Increase In Benefits</u>)
- Effect changes that result in a benefit decrease for the first month possible, allowing for NOAA.

MA EXCEPTION

The reported change may result in eligibility in another category or ineligibility. When this occurs, see Changes in MA Category.

FAA may become aware of a new source of earned income for a participant and there is already known budgeted earned income for the same participant. When this occurs, verify the new earned income and also any other earned income that will continue for that participant.
