I Transferring Deemed Newborn Categorical Coverage

Deemed Newborn Categorical Coverage may be transferred from one case to another for the remainder of the 12 month period, when any of the following occur:

 The Deemed Newborn was added in error (AE) to a case and coverage was approved on the case. Complete the following when this occurs:

Contact <u>FAA Systems Help Desk</u> to remove the Deemed Newborn from the case.

Add the Deemed Newborn to the correct case on CLIM, effective the first day of the month following the month of removal from the incorrect case.

- The Mother and Deemed Newborn are <u>currently receiving</u> (OC)
 MA benefits in another case. (See <u>Currently Receiving(Ir)</u>)
- The <u>Mother and Newborn move</u> (MB) out of the home together and continue to reside in Arizona. (See <u>Mother and Newborn</u> <u>Move(Ir)</u>)
- The Mother requests to <u>voluntarily withdraw</u> (VB) from MA. (See <u>Voluntary Withdrawal(Ir)</u>)

NOTE When transferring Deemed Newborn Categorical Coverage, an application is not required.
