04 Deemed Newborn Categorical Coverage - Overview

Deemed Newborn Categorical Medical Coverage is provided to a child reported as a live birth to a mother who was eligible for <u>Title XIX</u> MA in any category on the date of the child's birth.

When a miscarriage, stillbirth, or abortion is reported, see Removing a Participant Due to Stillbirth, Miscarriage, or Abortion to allow the S.O.B.R.A. Woman's postpartum coverage.

WARNING

A child born to a participant who was not Title XIX eligible when their child was born and who meets both of the following is not eligible for Deemed Newborn Categorical Coverage:

- Does not meet citizenship or qualified noncitizenship requirements
- Is eligible in the MD category
