(01/01/18 - 12/31/18) An overpayment (OP) is a benefit amount received by a household more than their entitled amount.

A <u>Potential Overpayment (OP) Referral (FAA-0526A)</u> form must be completed for the period of potential ineligibility or incorrect benefit amount. The completed FAA-0526A must be sent to the Overpayment Unit.

Overpayments may be discovered in various ways, including but not limited to, the following:

- Case read process or case audits
- Eligibility Interview
- DCSS Information
- Jobs Program Information
- Duplicate Benefit report
- Appeal Decisions
- Management Evaluation (ME)
- Office of Special Investigation (OSI)
- Quality Control (QC)
 - State Verification Exchange System (SVES)
