D AHCCCS Quality Control Administration (QCA) - Case Review Report

When QCA completes their review of a selected case, they notify the local office of the status of the case on the Quality Compliance Case Review Report (FAA-1230A). The following is a description of the fields on the report:

- SAMPLE Identifies the type of MA action being reviewed.
 (See <u>Types of QCA Reviews</u>)
- FINDINGS Identifies the outcome of the review as being correct, an error or containing a deficiency.
- FIRST LEVEL READ Identifies whether a first level occurred.
- RESPONSIBILITY Lists Codes to indicate the cause of the error. (See <u>Responsibility Code List</u>)
- DISCOVERY Lists the source of the discrepancy.

Copies of correct FAA-1230As are sent to the following:

- LOM of the originating office
- LOM of the maintenance office, when appropriate
- District PM of the originating local office
- District PM of the maintenance local office, when appropriate
- Policy Support Team (PST)

Copies of deficient and error FAA-1230As are sent to the following in addition to the prior list:

- Program Administrator
- Internal Operations
- State MA Quality Coordinator

When the local or district office chooses to challenge the QCA findings, see QCA Challenge Process.
