## 07 Office of Special Investigations (OSI) - Overview

The Office of Special Investigations (OSI) was created by legislative action to investigate welfare fraud. OSI is headquartered in Phoenix with field offices in Flagstaff and Tucson.

The three major units of OSI are the following:

 Field Operations - Responds to requests for investigations originating from various DES programs. Results of these investigations may disclose fraudulent activity and may result in any of the following:

Issuance of benefits

Decrease or denial of benefits

Recommendations for overpayments

Criminal or administrative adjudication

Location of an absent or non-custodial parent

Field Operations investigators are out stationed or assigned to FAA local offices.

 Fraud Operations - Prepares criminal prosecution cases involving all of the following:

CA EBT

Child Support Enforcement

FS regulation violations

Replacement checks

Unemployment Insurance

Child Care

Administrative Services - Provides clerical and system support to Field Operations, Fraud Operations, fingerprinting services, and fraud hotline services.

OSI has the authority to access case files, documents, and administrative records in FAA local offices. OSI conducts investigations for the following:

- Pre-approval investigations on applications to prevent benefits from being issued on fraudulent Applications.
- Post-approval investigations on programs in which benefits have already been approved, to stop ongoing fraudulent schemes to obtain benefits.

## **MA EXCEPTION**

Only cases in Maricopa and Pima counties requiring an investigation must be sent to AHCCCS Office of Program Integrity.
