The general public, employees, and participants may submit a request to investigate potential fraud. When this occurs, the following departments are responsible for acting upon the request:

- Office of Special Investigations (OSI)
- AHCCCS Office of Program Integrity (AOPI)

OSI and AOPI have the authority to access <u>case files(g)</u>, and administrative records in FAA local offices.

OSI conducts the following investigations:

 Pre-approval investigations on participants to prevent potential fraud for the following programs:

All CA, NA, and MA combo cases throughout the state.

MA only cases outside of the following areas:

- Apache Junction
- Maricopa County
- Pima County
- Santa Cruz County
- Post-approval investigations on participants already receiving benefits, to stop potential fraud.

AOPI conducts the following investigations on MA only cases:

Pre-approval investigations for residents of the following areas:

**Apache Junction** 

Maricopa County

Pima County (not including Ajo and Sells)

Santa Cruz County

 Post-approval investigations for all counties when both of the following apply:

Evidence that potential fraud occurred during the current or previous application period (initial or renewal).

MA is the only program.
