Pascua Yaqui (PY) Tribal TANF Program participants are required to comply with the following PY Personal Responsibility Agreement (PRA) requirements:

- Employment Referrals pre-compliance.
- Continued compliance with the PY Yoemem Organization for Employment and Member Enhancement (YOEME) Services Compliance Office. (See <u>PY YOEME Services Compliance</u> <u>Office for contact information)</u>
- <u>Dependent</u> children aged six through 18 are enrolled in and attending school or is home schooled full time and must ensure that the child is making progress in school.
- Dependent children are immunized in accordance with the schedule of immunizations required for school or childcare entry by the Arizona School/Child Care Immunization Law. The immunization requirement is waived when a parent or caretaker relative provides a signed statement including all of the following:

That they have received the Department of Health Services information about immunizations.

That they understand the risks and benefits of immunization.

That due to personal beliefs, they do not consent to the immunization of the child.

The PY YOEME Services Office monitors compliance with the PY PRA requirements. When PY YOEME notifies FAA that a participant fails to comply with any of the PY PRA requirements, FAA imposes progressive sanctions in AZTECS.
