.06 Family Benefit Cap Period (FBCP) – Hopi Tribal TANF

REVISION 03 (01/01/08 - 03/31/08)

Effective 11/01/07, the Hopi Tribal TANF Program implemented the FAA Policy Manual Family Benefit Cap Period (FBCP) policy. (See CA Family Benefit Cap Period)

A natural or adoptive parent (including minor parents), or a specified relative is assigned a FBCP of 60 consecutive months. The Hopi FBCP starts with the first month on or after November 1, 2007 in which the participant meets any of the following:

- Included in TANF CA or CA-PG benefits
- A mandatory participant in the TANF CA budgetary unit is coded DI or DF on SEPA
- A mandatory participant in the TANF CA budgetary unit who is coded OU on SEPA due to the receipt of SSI
- A minor parent who is included in the TANF CA budgetary unit of a specified relative, AND has a child who is also included

EXCEPTION

When a participant has an FBCP and moves to the Hopi TANF Program service delivery area, the FBCP period will continue when approved for Hopi TANF benefits.
