## **B** Eligibility Requirements - WMAT

REVISION 18 (10/01/11 - 10/31/11)

White Mountain Apache Tribe (WMAT) TANF eligibility is limited to otherwise eligible CA budgetary units that meet all of the following:

 The budgetary unit lives on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation. This includes budgetary units that moved from another state or Tribal area onto the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

## **EXCEPTION**

Participants who relocate for purposes of education, training, or onthe-job training approved by the WMAT TANF Program remain eligible to receive WMAT-TANF benefits when they are actively participating in the education, training, or on-the-job training program. They do not have to be residing on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

• At least one WMAT <a href="mailto:child(g)">child(g)</a> in the WMAT-TANF budgetary unit is an enrolled WMAT Tribal member.

WMAT-TANF participants may not receive duplicate assistance from the state or other <u>Tribal CA Programs</u>.

Determine CA eligibility following state CA policy when a CA participant does NOT meet one of the following WMAT eligibility requirements:

- Reside in the WMAT Service Delivery Area (SDA)
- Include an enrolled WMAT child

WMAT participants do NOT have a choice between state or WMAT TANF. When an applicant resides in the WMAT SDA and includes an enrolled WMAT child, the budgetary unit is referred to WMAT TANF.
