G Program Noncompliance - White Mountain Apache TANF

Impose a sanction against the budgetary unit when any participant does not comply with Jobs. Jobs staff make all good cause determinations related to noncompliance.

Sanctions consist of a series of benefit reductions. The reductions end in case closure.

The sanction levels for noncompliance are as follows:

- A cash reduction of \$50 for the first month of noncompliance.
- A cash reduction of \$75 for the second month of noncompliance.
- Close the case for the third month of noncompliance.
- Close the case for every future occurrence of noncompliance, after the first three noncompliance sanctions have been imposed.

Jobs staff sends the applicable sanction notices to the budgetary unit.

When <u>imposing a sanction</u> or closing a case for noncompliance, use the same keying procedures as those used for CA progressive sanctioning.

Review WERE to ensure that it is keyed correctly for WMAT-TANF. (See <u>WMAT-TANF WERE Keying Requirements</u>) AZTECS deducts the correct benefit amount for each sanction level keyed on DISA.
