## **B** Treatment of Food Distribution Budgetary Units

REVISION 42 (06/01/16 - 07/31/16)

Budgetary units may not receive both NA and Food Distribution Program (FDP) benefits in the same month. The local office must determine when eligible budgetary units are participating in an FDP before approving NA.

Budgetary units approved for NA but receiving zero benefits in any month, are eligible to apply and receive FDP benefits for that month.

The Food Distribution Program (FDP) Participation (FA-559) form is used for the following:

By FAA:

To inquire on the budgetary unit's FDP participation status.

To inquire on the status of an FDP Intentional Program Violation (IPV).

By FDP:

To inquire on the budgetary unit's NA participation status.

To inquire on the status of an NA IPV.
