## D AFIP Requirements - Exemptions from Fingerprint Imaging

Exemptions from the fingerprint imaging requirements are as follows:

## Permanent

This exemption includes, but is not limited to, mandatory AFIP participants who meet either of the following conditions:

- Participants missing both the right and left index fingers.
- Participants with a physical disability or mental illness that does not allow the participant to place at least one index finger on a fingerprint imaging scanning device.

## Temporary

This exemption includes, but is not limited to, mandatory AFIP participants who meet any of the following conditions:

• Mandatory AFIP participants meeting a temporary exemption are exempt until the next renewal conducted in the local office. This exemption includes, but is not limited to, mandatory AFIP participants who meet any of the following conditions:

Participants who have injuries to both index fingers that prevent a quality fingerprint imaging to be taken.

Participants whose fingerprint images are determined to be unusable by AFIP.

Participants who are interviewed in their home, at an itinerant site, or by telephone.

- Mandatory AFIP participants unable to attend the local office interview.
- Mandatory AFIP participants who cannot be fingerprint imaged at the local office due to a malfunction or maintenance of the <u>AFIP workstation</u> or <u>AFIP portable</u> unit.
- Hospitalized participants.

When a participant meets an exemption, document the <u>case file(g)</u>. Documentation may include any of the following:

- AFIP Enrollment Receipt
- Licensed physician's statements
- Case Record History (FA-015) form
- CADO
