B AFIP Imaging Exceptions - Administrative Errors

An administrative error is incorrect information keyed in AFIP, which is subsequently identified in AFIP as a potential <u>fingerprint imaging exception</u>. When an administrative error has occurred, the <u>AFIP</u> Central Workstation completes the following:

- Updates the AFIP database with the correct AZTECS <u>Client</u> <u>Identifying Number(g)</u> (CIN) and biographical information (See AFIP Enrollment Procedures)
- Updates tracking mechanisms

Once aware of an administrative error, the local office must notify the AFIP Central Operator by e-mail. (See <u>AFIP Address</u>)

When notified of an administrative error match by the AFIP Central Operator, the local office must complete the following:

- Review the <u>case files(g)</u> in question with the AFIP Central Operator
- Make changes in AZTECS, when necessary
- Document the case files and the original AFIP enrollment receipt with the correct information
