03 EBT QUEST Card - Overview

The QUEST Card is used to control access to EBT benefits in a participant's account when the payee enters their PIN. The PIN is a four-digit number known only to the payee.

The participant may choose their PIN by one of the following:

- Calling the JP Morgan Automated Response Unit (ARU) (See <u>EBT</u> <u>Help Desk Phone Number</u>)
- Requesting the PIN to be mailed to them by JP Morgan

The PI is always the primary payee on the EBT case. A maximum of three payees (the PI and two alternate card holders) may be on each case. Each payee on an EBT case is issued a QUEST Card and selects, or is mailed, their PIN. (See Establishing EBT Accounts)

Policy and procedures regarding the QUEST card are outlined as follows:
