## J Vital Statistics Report (CR212)

The Vital Statistics Report (CR212) provides a listing of matching Social Security Numbers (SSN) in AZTECS that match the Death Tape from Vital Statistics. This report is considered primary verification, and DOES NOT require additional verification. The CR212 is accessed through the <u>SAR System</u> using the SAR Job VJHID150.

The CR212 MUST be assigned to staff through ACTS, using the Change Type Code DP. The EI has ten calendar days to determine the affect of the death of the for the remaining participant's ongoing eligibility. (See <u>Participant Maintenance</u>)

The CR212 provides the following information:

- Case number
- Case name
- Decedent's name
- Decedent's SSN
- Decedent's date of birth
- Decedent's date of death
- Program decedent is involved in
- Program status

## **MA EXCEPTION**

Special procedures apply to MA when there is a death of the PI. (See MA Emergency Representative)
