02 General Assistance (GA)

The General Assistance (GA) Program is an interim assistance program provided to disabled persons during the period an SSA application has been filed and an SSA eligibility determination is being completed. Applicants for GA must meet one of the following requirements:

- They are disabled to the degree that they are unemployable. (See GA Medical Disability
- They are needy and required to do both of the following:
 Live in the same home with a disabled person
 Provide custodial care to the disabled person with whom they live.
 (See Adult Caretaker)

A participant may receive up to 18 months of GA during ANY <u>36-consecutive</u> month period of time.
