Advocates for the Disabled assists homeless persons in the SSI or SSI/SSA disability application.

EXCEPTION

Advocates for the Disabled offers assistance to Arizona residents regardless whether they are homeless, who meet any of the following criteria:

- Have an active claim for SSI or SSI/SSA disability benefits, such as a denial that is being appealed.
- Have been notified that their SSI or SSI/SSA disability benefits status may be discontinued.
- Are diagnosed HIV positive and have applied for SSI benefits.

Complete a referral when a participant has a physical disability or mental illness that is expected to last at least 12 months.

NOTE Social disabilities must be considered.

Participants who are determined to be potentially eligible for SSI comprise the targeted group for referral.

WARNING

Referrals to Advocates for the Disabled may be completed even when it is questionable whether a participant is eligible for services. Advocates for the Disabled makes the final determination of eligibility for their services.
