A State Assistance Residency Requirements

Residency requirements for State Assistance are as follows:

 For General Assistance (GA), participants must currently reside in Arizona with the intention of making Arizona their home.

For participants living in institutions, see <u>GA Residency in an</u> <u>Institution</u>.

For participants living on Indian reservations, see <u>GA</u> <u>Residency on an Indian Reservation</u>.

• For Tuberculosis Control (TC), the Department of Health Services (DHS) is responsible for the determination of residency. When a residency becomes questionable, refer it in writing through local office management, to the local DHS office.

When budgetary units transfer between counties, see <u>TC</u> <u>Transfer Between Counties</u>.

When budgetary units leave the state, see <u>TC Move Out of</u> <u>State</u>.
