## **B** State Assistance Citizenship Verification

Accept only the originals of the following documents to verify a participant's U.S. citizenship:

 Certified birth certificate issued by any of the following bureaus of vital statistics:

United States (U.S.) government

State government

Local government

- Certificate of Birth (FS-545 or DS-1350) issued by the U.S. State Department.
- Report of Birth Abroad of a U.S. Citizen (FS 240) issued by the U.S. State Department.
- Certificate of Naturalization (N-550 or N-570) issued by the U.S. Department of Justice.
- American Indian census record.
  - NOTE The tribal boundaries of a federally recognized U.S.
    Native American Indian Tribe may extend into a
    foreign country. Treat enrolled members of that tribe
    born outside the U.S. the same as a citizen of the
    U.S.
- Certificate of Citizenship (N-560 or N-561) issued by the U.S. Department of Justice.
- U.S. Citizen Identification card (I-197).
- Identification Card for Use of Resident Citizen (I-179).
- U.S. Passport.
- Verification from the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) that establishes U.S. citizenship.
