D Local Office Medical Eligibility Decision

Consider the GA participant unemployable when acceptable verification of a <u>medical disability</u> is provided. (See <u>Medical Disability</u> Information and Verification for acceptable verification)

Ensure that the following is documented:

- The cause of unemployability when making the decision at the local office level (<u>FA-196</u>, Part C, Section 1 or Section 3)
- The period of disability (FA-196, Part C, Section 2)
- The reason for ineligibility when the participant is not determined to be disabled or an eligible a<u>dult caretaker</u>

Refer the case to the District Medical Consultant (DMC) when any of the following occurs:

- The participant does not appear to have a medical disability that can be determined at the local office level.
- There is a combination of a <u>medical disability</u> and a <u>social</u> <u>disability</u>, but disability cannot be determined at the local office level.
- A doctor's statement or other proof of medical disability is not acceptable.

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
