H Scheduling Medical Appointments

Medical appointments, subject to supervisory approval, can be made to establish eligibility under the <u>GA Medical Disability</u> criteria to assist in either of the following:

- A local office medical eligibility decision.
- A <u>DMC medical and social disability decision</u>.

The participant may not have enough medical information to establish disability. (See <u>Medical Disability Information and Verification</u>) When this occurs, the local office, based on supervisory approval, can arrange a medical appointment for the participant with a doctor contracted by FAA. (See <u>Scheduling Medical Appointments</u>)

When the local office schedules a medical appointment the following apply:

• The local office provides the participant an Authorization for Medical Examination (FA-194) form to advise them of the following:

The time and place of the appointment.

The consequences for failure to appear for the appointment.

• The local office provides the participant with a Medical Statement (FA-196).
