B GA Interim Assistance Authorization - Form Effective Dates

The Interim Assistance Reimbursement Authorization (FA-409) form remains in effect for the longer of the following dates:

- One year from the date it is signed by the participant.
- Through the month that SSA makes an initial payment on the participant's claim.
- Through the period that SSA makes a final denial determination on the participant's claim including decisions on appeals.
- Through the month that FAA and the participant agree to terminate the interim assistance authorization.

EXCEPTION

FAA will not agree to terminate the interim assistance authorization when any interim assistance benefits are paid for the period of time covered by the authorization. (See <u>Interim Assistance</u> Reimbursement)

When terminating an interim assistance authorization, document CANCELED across the top of the copy of the authorization form in the case file. Place the canceled form in the permanent verification section of the case file. Send a copy of the canceled form to the appropriate SSA office.
