10 GA Interim Assistance Authorization - Overview

As a condition of GA eligibility, all participants must sign an Interim Assistance Reimbursement Authorization (FA-409) form. Proof that a copy of the FA-409 was provided to and received by the Social Security Administration (SSA) must be in the case file or verified before the application can be approved.

The FA-409 authorizes SSA to withhold the participant's first SSI (retroactive lump sum) payment and forward the payment to FAA as reimbursement for GA interim assistance paid. (See Interim Assistance Reimbursement)

EXCEPTION

GA <u>adult caretakers</u> are not required to sign the FA-409.
