W State Assistance Types of Unearned Income - Social Security Administration (SSA) Benefits

Social Security Administration (SSA) benefits, including Retirement, Survivors, and Disability Insurance (RSDI) and Supplemental Security Income (SSI), are COUNTABLE when paid to any of the following State Assistance eligible participants:

- Wage earners. This includes the disabled person cared for by a GA adult caretaker.
- Dependents or survivors of the eligible wage earner.

Key the gross converted income in the UNEARNED OTHER INCOME field on STAA. (See <u>Budgeting Income</u>)

WARNING

SSA benefits may be reduced to collect an SSI or SSA overpayment. Do NOT add in the recoupment amount when determining the COUNTABLE SSA benefit amount.

GA EXCEPTION

When the participant's spouse receives SSI, any SSA benefits received with the SSI benefits are NOT COUNTABLE to the participant.
