Change: New Tribal TANF Denial/Closure Reason Code

EFFECTIVE DATE: For eligibility determinations completed on or after 09/12/2022

A new CA Denial/Closure Reason Code has been created for CA applications that meet the Salt River Pima Maricopa Indian Community (SRP-MIC) Tribal TANF criteria.

When a participant who resides on the SRP-MIC reservation turns in a CA application to FAA and meets the SRP-MIC criteria, the CA application is denied.

Ensure all appropriate AZTECS screens are keyed to identify the application as an SRP-MIC TANF case prior to denial.

Key the SR Denial/Closure Reason code in the DENIAL CLOSURE REASON field on AFED to deny the CA. Complete the Tribal/FAA Turn Around Document (TAD) FAA-1125A form and send the form to the SRP-MIC LEARN office.

Reminder: Replacement of Benefits - Food Destroyed in a Disaster

A participant may report non-receipt of benefits or that their food was destroyed due to a personal disaster. When this occurs refer to [FAA1.H01](#) titled Replacement of Benefits – Replacement Issuance.

When a large area is declared a disaster by the President of the United States, or Arizona's State Plan is approved by the Food and Nutrition Service, the Disaster Nutrition Assistance Program (DNAP) policy applies. The DNAP is a completely different program from the regular NA program.
