Additional directions are needed when an Able Bodied Adult Without Dependents (ABAWD) exemption or work requirement is met.

When a participant's NA case is closed due to the ABAWD time limit and the participant notifies FAA that they meet an exemption or work requirement, the participant may regain eligibility. Determine whether NA benefits can be reopened and redetermine eligibility. When reopening an NA case, ensure the appropriate codes are keyed on REPT. (See <u>FAA2.M09C</u> titled ABAWD Continued Eligibility for the AZTECS Keying Procedures and new examples.)

When an ABAWD participant is disqualified and the remaining budgetary unit members continue to be eligible for NA benefits, reported ABAWD eligibility information is treated as a change. (See <u>FAA6.D02D</u> titled Effective Date for Adding a Participant for assistance with determining the effective date of the change.)
