

FAA5.J Medical Assistance Income Maximum (MAIM)

01 MAIM - Purpose

MAIM displays the first of three income tests used to determine MA eligibility in the following:

- [31 Individual MA](#)
- [31E Individual MA](#)

Access MAIM to display the results of the income maximum test by selecting the participant for review on MADA.

In the right hand column, MAIM displays information that applies to legally responsible participants for the participant whose eligibility is being determined.

In the lower left hand corner of the screen, MAIM displays one of the following edit messages:

- CLIENT HAS PASSED THE INCOME MAX TEST
- CLIENT HAS FAILED THE INCOME MAX TEST

To be eligible in [31 Individual MA](#), a participant's budgetary unit total countable income must meet the [per person share](#) of the MA Income Maximum. (See [MA Income Standard](#))

FAA5.J Medical Assistance Income Maximum (MAIM)

AZTECS uses information from the income screens to display prorated and allocated income based on information keyed in the POS PARENT and POS SP fields on SEPA.

AZTECS adds the participant's total prorated income and the total prorated income allocated from other financially responsible participants. The amount is then compared to the per person share of the MA Income Maximum Limit.

To review AZTECS income screens from which MAIM has drawn information, set the cursor to the left of the item to be reviewed. Key an X in the space and press ENTER. AZTECS advances to the applicable screen.
