

.01 AZTECS Problem Resolutions - AZTECS Deauthorized Cases - Deauthorized Case Situations

Situations that result in [deauthorization\(g\)](#) include, but are not limited to, the following:

- The first benefit month for renewal applications.
- The benefit month in which a CA dependent child turns 18 (see [Deauth - Cash 18](#)), or [will turn 19](#).
- The benefit month in which an NA participant with income turns the 18. (See [Deauth - NA 18](#))
- The benefit month created by the APEM [Copy Details](#) function.
- The benefit month after benefits have been withheld for [TPEP noncompliance](#).
- The benefit month in which a benefit amount being recouped changes. (See [OP Claim/Redetermine Benefits](#), or [Deauth - Recoupment Diff Found](#))
- The benefit month following a prorated benefit month. (See [Deauth - Prorated Ben Found](#))
- The benefit month a participant is added to an MA budgetary unit.

MA EXCEPTION

Benefits do not deauthorize when the participant is added to a TMA budgetary unit.

- The benefit month a Deemed Newborn is added to an MA budgetary unit by the [newborn automated process](#).
- At [monthly rollover](#) when there is a progressive sanction imposed. (See [CA Deauth - Prog Sanction](#))
- The benefit month a CA case is closed in a CA and NA combination case.
- The benefit month before an [Unwed Minor Parent](#) (UMP) in a CA case turns the age of 18. (See [CA Deauth - UM Ending](#))

- The benefit month a change is made to information affecting eligibility on a case in which benefits have been authorized, and either of the following apply:

Benefits have not yet paid

MA eligibility has not yet transmitted to AHCCCS
