## 06 Returned Mail Procedures

## **REVISION 51**

(01/01/23 - 12/31/23) Returned mail is considered <u>unclear information(g)</u>. Returned mail with a forwarding address is not verification that a participant has moved, only that there has been a change of mailing address. (See <u>Verifying Reported</u> <u>Changes</u> for more information on when verification is required.)

When FAA receives undeliverable mail from the United States Postal Service (USPS), all returned envelopes with a forwarding address label are scanned and uploaded into OnBase.

When there is a forwarding address label from USPS on the envelope, AZTECS automatically completes **all** of the following:

- Updates the mailing address in AZTECS
- Scans and uploads the envelope into OnBase
- Sends an X006 notice and generates an RM ACTS Alert, when the budgetary unit is assigned to standard reporting

When there is a forwarding address label from the USPS on the envelope, ensure the mailing address in HEAplus and AZTECS is updated. (See <u>Keying Addresses on ADDR</u>)
