D Mandatory Alerts

REVISION 50 (01/01/22 - 12/31/22)

The following conditions require that either a Person or Program Alert Code must be keyed on PRAP:

- Controlled substance NA disqualification (C1, C2, as applicable)
- Drug conviction (FD)
- Failure to comply with immunization procedures (IM)
- Failure to comply with <u>Jobs</u> (JB)
- Failure to comply with <u>school attendance</u> (SA)
- Failure to cooperate with <u>DCSS</u> (CS)
- Failure to cooperate with <u>Quality Control</u> (Q3)
- Fleeing felon, CA (FF)
- Fraud determined (FR)

NOTE The FR Alert Code must be keyed next to the participant. When the FR Alert Code displays on PRAP, call <u>OARC</u> to determine the state in which the fraud was committed and the length of the disqualification period.

- Fraudulent statement or multiple benefits (NA)
- <u>Intentional Program Violation</u> (IP)
- Refusal to cooperate with <u>Quality Control</u> (QC)
- Trafficking in NA benefits (FT)
- <u>Voluntary quit</u> or reduced work hours (VQ)

The following Participant Disqualification Alert Code types must be keyed in the third alert type field on PRAP next to the disqualified participant, regardless of the number of other person alerts:

- FD (Felony Drug Conviction)
- FF (Fleeing Felon)
- IP (IPV)

NOTE Keying these alert types in the first or second alert type field on PRAP next to the disqualified elderly participant or person with a disability incorrectly allows the household special consideration.
