.01 CA PRA Sanction Notification

REVISION 45 (01/01/17 - 12/31/17)

When a participant does not comply with a CA PRA requirement, a sanction is imposed.

Noncompliance notification occurs in one of the following ways:

- FAA receives a Sanctions Noncompliance/Compliance Request email from DCSS. FAA issues the <u>NOAA</u> to the noncompliant participant and imposes the sanction. (See <u>Sanction Notices</u>)
- FAA receives an ACTS alert generated by Jobs to impose a Jobs sanction. Jobs issues the NOAA to the noncompliant participant.
- The CA DEAUTH GRAD SANC ACTS alert is generated monthly by AZTECS when rollover occurs and a budgetary unit has an ongoing sanction. (See <u>Imposing Ongoing CA</u> <u>Sanction</u>)
- FAA receives a Felony Drug Conviction Crossmatch Report. When this occurs, send the Verification of Drug Conviction (C020) notice.
 - NOTE When the Felony Drug Conviction Crossmatch Report is received with Superior Court of Arizona minutes attached, the C020 is not required. Effect the decrease or stop the benefits for the first possible month, allowing for the NOAA.
