

G Ending CA Sanctions

See [Reapplication After Sanctions](#) for either of the following:

- To end a 100% sanction.
- To end a 25% or 50% sanction when the case was closed for other reasons.

When the Jobs Program staff have generated an alert of compliance the sanction is ended. To end a 25% or 50% sanction in an active CA case, a new application is not required. Complete the following:

- End the sanction for the first month possible, following the month of the mandatory sanction period.
- Key the SANC END field with the date for which benefits may be increased to the 100% level. When there is more than one sanction being ended, key the month for each.
- Process through **AFPD** to authorize the restored benefits. It may be necessary to authorize CA supplements. (See [Authorize a CA Supplement](#)) When applicable, remove the [SA income](#) and authorize MA and NA.
- Send the [A741 notice](#).

EXCEPTION

There may be situations when FAA ends a 25%, 50%, or 100% Jobs sanction including, but not limited to, the following:

- A 100% sanction has been imposed stopping the CA benefits and a new application is received. (See [Reapplication After Sanctions](#) and [Intent to Comply](#))

NOTE Intent to comply does not apply to Tribal TANF sanctions.

- The CA case closed for other reasons and a 25% or 50% sanction was imposed. (See [Reapplication After Sanctions](#))
- FAA does not receive another instance of noncompliance by the day after NOAA. Document the reason that the sanction was ended on DISA.
