

## C Verification of Identity

**REVISION 26**  
(10/01/13 - 12/31/13)

Accept any document that establishes the applicant's identity. Acceptable documents include, but are not limited to the following:

- Birth certificate
- Citizenship and immigration documents
- Driver's license
- Family census card
- ID card from health benefits or another assistance or social service program
- [Motor Vehicle Division \(MVD\) website photo](#)
- School ID
- Wage stubs
- Work ID
- Voter registration card
- Other reasonable written sources

Do not accept consular identification cards that are issued by a foreign government as a valid form of identity verification.

### **NA EXCEPTION**

Request alternate forms of identity verification other than a consular identification card. Accept the consular identification card when it is the participant's **ONLY** form of identity verification.

When documents are not available, use a [collateral verification](#) when possible.

### **MA EXCEPTION**
