

A Refugee Cash Assistance (RCA)

Refugees must be screened and determined INELIGIBLE for CA before they can be considered for the Refugee Cash Assistance (RCA) program. When a refugee budgetary unit qualifies for CA, they CANNOT be placed in the RCA program.

A separate application must be completed for each RCA budgetary unit, regardless of the number of budgetary units living in the same residence.

RCA budgetary units are [Basic categorically eligible](#) for NA.

Key RE in the CI field on IDCI for refugees eligible for RCA. When qualified noncitizen refugees are eligible for CA, key EA.
