

A ABAWD - Work Requirements

Compliance with ABAWD work requirements means that the participant meets one of the following:

- Work 80 hours per month.

NOTE The actual, non-converted hours include regular employment and self-employment.

Key EM in the WERE EXPT RSN FS field.

- Employment of more than 30 hours a week or in which the weekly earnings are equivalent to the Federal minimum wage multiplied by 30 hours.

Key EM in the WERE EXPT RSN FS field.

- Work 20 or more hours per week, averaged monthly

NOTE The actual, non-converted hours include self employment, volunteer work, and in-kind work.

Key the EM Code in the WERE EXPT RSN FS field.

- Participate and comply 20 or more hours per week of job search or job search training with one of the following programs:

[Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act \(WIOA\)](#)

[Trade Adjustment Assistance Act \(TAA\)](#)

NOTE The SNA E&T Program will coordinate work requirement verification with the WIOA and TAA programs.

Key PC in the WERE EXPT RSN FS field when alerts are received from SNA E &T.

When the participant's work hours fall below 20 per week, it is their responsibility to report the change in accordance with reporting requirements.

Hours earned outside of regular paid employment, such as volunteer work and in-kind work, will be monitored by SNA E&T for compliance. These individuals must be referred for monitoring.

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
