

C Eligible Months for Tribal CA-PG

Tribal TANF benefits can be approved for the three months before the expected delivery date (EDD) month. (See Example [Tribal CA-PG Eligibility](#))

When a pregnant participant turns in an application for benefits in the fourth month before the month of the EDD, complete the following:

- NEXT to APMA and change the benefit proration date to the first day of the following month for CA.
- Process the second month and authorize Tribal CA-PG (when eligible) on the appropriate determination screens.
- Send appropriate notices informing the PI of the determination.
- Document the case file with the reason CA benefits were prorated to the next month.

When a pregnant participant turns in an application for benefits MORE THAN four months before the month of the EDD, complete the following:

- NEXT to AFED and deny the Tribal TANF application, by keying DC in the DENIAL CLOSURE REASON field.
- Advise the participant when she may apply for Tribal CA-PG.
- Send Denial and Approval Notices (when applicable) informing the PI of the determination.
- Document the case file with information to support the determination.
