

C Good Cause Reasons for DCSS Noncompliance

Good cause for not cooperating in establishing paternity or securing support exists in the following situations:

- Key G1 in the AF COOPERATION CODE and MA COOPERATION CODE fields on APPD when reasonably anticipated to result in PHYSICAL harm to the child,
This includes physical harm to the parent or specified relative with whom the child lives, when it reduces their capacity to care for the child.
- Key G2 in the AF COOPERATION CODE and MA COOPERATION CODE fields on APPD when reasonably anticipated to result in EMOTIONAL harm to the child.
This includes the parent or specified relative with whom the child lives, when it reduces their capacity to care for the child.
- Key G3 in the AF COOPERATION CODE and MA COOPERATION CODE fields on APPD when legal proceedings for ADOPTION are PENDING before a court.
- Key G4 in the AF COOPERATION CODE and MA COOPERATION CODE fields on APPD in a public or licensed private SOCIAL AGENCY adoption situation.
This situation exists when discussions to resolve the issue of giving the child up for adoption have not gone on for longer than three months.
- KEY G5 in the AF COOPERATION CODE and MA COOPERATION CODE fields on APPD when the child was conceived as a result of SEXUAL ASSAULT.
- Key G6 in the AF COOPERATION CODE and MA COOPERATION CODE fields on APPD when the child was conceived as a result of INCEST.
