

B Restored NA Benefits

Restored NA benefits are issued when it is discovered that the budgetary unit is entitled to them and the case is in either a denied or closed status. The budgetary unit is not required to take any action. This includes extreme delays in processing for a period of 12 months or longer.

NOTE When CA or NA are in open status and benefits have already been issued, see [Supplemental Benefits](#).

Restore benefits for no more than 12 months prior to whichever of the following occurs first:

- The date FAA received a request for restoration of benefits from a budgetary unit.
- The date FAA was notified or discovered that a loss of benefits occurred.
- The date the budgetary unit requested an [Appeal](#) because it disagreed with an adverse action that resulted in a loss of benefits.
- The date of notification that an [Intentional Program Violation \(IPV\)](#) disqualification was reversed.
- The date the budgetary unit receives a favorable decision through the Appeal process, a judicial action, or other court action.
- The date FAA discovered an application was processed untimely.
