.01 Methods of NA Overpayment Collection – Cash Repayment

REVISION 47 (01/01/19 - 12/31/19)

When the household is financially able to pay the NA overpayment at one time, The Office of Accounts Receivable and Collections (OARC) may collect a lump sum cash payment. The household is not required to liquidate all of its resources in order to make one lump sum payment.

OARC accepts the following methods of payment:

- A lump sum payment.
- Full or partial payment in cash and with NA benefits. (See <u>Repayment With NA Benefits</u>)
- The Department may allow the household to pay a claim in equal monthly payments based on the following claim amounts
 12 monthly payments when the claim is \$600 or less
 24 monthly payments when the claim is \$1200 or less
 36 monthly payments when the claim is over \$1200
- The amount of the overpayment may be compromised when the household does not have sufficient income and <u>liquid</u> <u>assets</u> to repay the total amount in three years. (See <u>Compromising NA Overpayments</u>)
