

.06 DSED Disaster Gross Monthly Income Standard (NA)

Effective October 01, 2018

When Arizona chooses to use a Disaster Standard Expense Deduction (DSED) during the Disaster Nutrition Assistance Program (DNAP), the disaster gross monthly income maximum is determined by adding the following amounts: [NA net income standard](#), [standard deduction amount](#), [maximum shelter deduction](#) and the following Disaster Standard Expense Deduction:
