Effective January 1, 2021

The Disaster Nutrition Assistance Program ([DNAP](#)) NA disaster gross monthly income maximum is determined by adding the following amounts: [NA net income standard](#), [standard deduction amount](#), and the [maximum shelter deduction](#).

The maximum allotment is a 15% temporary increase of the Thrifty Food Plan, extended to 09/30/2021. This extension is granted by the approval of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (PL 117-2).
