

## I Tribal Enrollment - WMAT

Enrolled White Mountain Apache Tribe (WMAT) TANF Program participants are required to provide a copy of their Tribal Affidavit or Tribal Identification as verification of tribal enrollment.

WMAT enrolled or non-enrolled pregnant women in their third trimester with no other children may be eligible for CA benefits.

When a non-enrolled pregnant woman applies for WMAT-TANF benefits, all of the following apply:

- The unborn child must be potentially eligible for WMAT enrollment for the non-enrolled pregnant women to be potentially eligible. A participant's statement is acceptable verification of potential WMAT enrollment for the unborn.
- The unborn must be enrolled with the WMAT within six months after the month they are born.
- Verification of the child's enrollment must be provided at the first interview following the month the child turns six months of age.

When the father is an enrolled WMAT member, the budgetary unit is eligible when the budgetary unit meets all other CA eligibility criteria.
