

01 **Arizona Fingerprint Imaging Program (AFIP) - Overview**

The Arizona Fingerprint Imaging Program (AFIP) is an automated fingerprint comparison system for use in the eligibility determination process. AFIP is designed to ensure that participants do not use false identities to receive benefits for which they are not entitled.

Do not release Fingerprint Image Records or AFIP Enrollment Receipts to anyone.

Fingerprint imaging is used only for the purposes of determining eligibility and preventing participants from receiving duplicate benefits.

Fingerprint imaging is a condition of eligibility for programs administered by FAA. This includes [State Assistance Programs](#) (GA, RRP, TC).

MA EXCEPTION

Fingerprint imaging is NOT a condition of eligibility.
