

F DMC Medical and Social Disability Decision

A District Medical Consultant (DMC) decision is necessary when one of the following occurs:

- A participant does not meet any of the criteria needed to make a [local office medical eligibility decision](#), but may be eligible based on a combination of the following:
 - A [Medical Disability](#)
 - A [Social Disability](#)
- The local office is unable to make a medical eligibility decision because the information provided by a doctor is insufficient to establish eligibility.

The disability determination is made by the DMC in consultation with employment and rehabilitation specialists of the Department.

Forward all the following to the DMC:

- Employability Data (FA-191) form, completed at the GA interview when available medical information is unclear.
- DMC Certification of Unemployability (FA-192) form.
- Originals of all medical reports including any prior medical records in the case file.

NOTE Place copies of all medical reports in the permanent verification section of the case file.

The DMC documents all findings on the FA-192 and returns it to the local office.
