#### Change: Reported Death of the CA PI Procedures

EFFECTIVE DATE: For eligibility determinations completed on or after 07/27/2020

This change was made to clarify the procedures when the death of a CA PI is reported.

When the death of a CA PI is reported and there are remaining budgetary unit participants the following apply:

- When a CA application is pending, deny the CA by keying the DH Denial Closure Reason Code on AFED.
- When the death of the CA PI is reported during an approval period, a CA EBT Alternate Card Holder may be established.

When a CA EBT Alternate Card Holder is not established, complete the following:

- Key the OU Participation Code in the PT field in SEPA next to the PI.
- Key the DH code in the INELIG RSN field in SEPA.
- Key the DH Denial Closure Code in AFED and close the case allowing for NOAA.

# Reminder: Deprivation Eligibility Factor for Cash Assistance

Cash Assistance (CA) shares many eligibility factors with Nutrition Assistance (NA). A list of eligibility factors for CA and NA is located in the CNAP Manual at FAA6.001A.

One eligibility factor that is exclusive to CA is deprivation of a dependent child. When a dependent child has been deprived of the care and support of a parent or both parents, the dependent child is potentially eligible to receive CA. Deprivation is the first eligibility factor to be considered when processing a determination for CA. When deprivation is verified, a parent, a sibling or a nonparent caretaker relative who live with the dependent child may also be eligible to receive CA.

For more information, see policy at <u>FAA1.A11A</u> which has been enhanced to strengthen the concept of deprivation.

### General Information: Extended Benefit - Unemployment Benefit Claims

Starting July 17, 2020, the state law provides for the payment of up to 13 weeks of additional benefits during periods of high unemployment in Arizona.

The Extended Benefits (EB) period is available for those who have exhausted their regular unemployment insurance benefits as well as the additional 13-week extension provided by the Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC).

The weekly benefit amount (WBA) under the EB program is the same as the participant received for regular unemployment compensation (between \$184-\$240 per week).

EB is budgeted as regular UI income and is countable for Nutrition Assistance and Refugee Cash Assistance (RCA). EB is not countable for Cash Assistance (CA).

Complete one of the following on UNIN:

- For NA and CA, key the UI Unearned Income Code
- For RCA, key the UI OT Unearned Income Code

Key the weekly amount on UNIC in the month it is received using the WK frequency code.
