# Change: PY Tribal TANF No Longer Determined by FAA

EFFECTIVE DATE: For applications received on or after 05/01/2023

The Pascua Yaqui (PY) Tribal TANF is now determined by PY Yoemem Organization for Employment and Member Enhancement (YOEME) Services outside of AZTECS.

When a CA application is received on or after 05/01/2023 and a participant indicates they are a PY Tribal member, review the application at the interview to determine whether the application should be referred to the PY Social Services Department.

A CA budgetary unit may be eligible for PY TANF eligibility when **one** of the following applies:

- The budgetary unit lives on PY tribal lands and at least one participant is enrolled in a federally recognized tribe.
- The budgetary unit lives in the PY Service Delivery Area and at least one participant is an enrolled PY Tribal member.

Follow the procedures listed in <u>FAA6.I06D</u> titled Referral Process – Pascua Yaqui Tribal TANF to send PY YOEME staff the applicant information listed in the Tribal/FAA – Turn Around Document (FAA-1125A) form. PY Tribal TANF is determined outside of AZTECS. CA applications received that are potentially eligible for PY Tribal TANF is denied with the PY Denial Closure Reason Code and the Cash Assistance Deny/Closure PY TANF (A636) notice is sent.

NOTE When NA is attached to a CA application that meets the PY TANF criteria, continue to process the NA application.

Ongoing PY TANF cases and PY TANF applications received before 05/01/2023 are paid out by FAA for the benefit month of 05/2023.

For new PY TANF applications received before 05/01/2023, determine CA eligibility in AZTECS. Follow normal keying procedures necessary in making a CA eligibility decision. Review and key the following screens to ensure that an eligibility decision is made correctly for the PY TANF Program:

#### ADDR

Key PY in the RESERVATION field when the budgetary unit is living on the Pascua Yaqui Indian Reservation in Pima county.

When the budgetary unit does not live on the Pascua Yaqui Indian Reservation, they are considered off-Reservation Pascua Yaqui members. Do not key a Reservation Code on ADDR.

#### RARE

Key Y in the Al RACE field and the appropriate Tribal Code in the TRIBE field next to any participant who is enrolled in a federally recognized Indian Tribe.

Key the participant's tribal census enrollment number in the TRIBAL CENSUS field, when known.

#### WERE

Key P (Pascua Yaqui exempt) in the AF EXPT RSN field next to each participant in the budgetary unit. This must be keyed so AZTECS identifies the budgetary unit as a Pascua Yaqui Tribal TANF Program case.

#### APPD

Key EX in the AF COOPERATION CODE field. This must be keyed so that the participant is not referred to DCSS.

#### EXNS

Key A1 in the STD LVL field on EXNS. Verification of a shelter cost obligation is not required.

#### WORW

Key RT in the PAR/EXEM field next to any participant who are mandatory PY Tribal Employment referrals.

#### AFED

When all eligibility factors have been met, approve the case up to 05/2023.

After copy details to 06/01/2023, Key PY in the DENIAL CLOSURE REASON field on AFED to deny the CA. Send the Your TANF Will be Closed (A220) notice.

NOTE Child support income, cash gifts, legal settlements, and lottery or gambling winnings are not countable for PY Tribal TANF. The first \$500 plus 50% of the remaining balance of earnings received from Jobs or Tribal NEW are not countable for PY Tribal TANF.

# Reminder: SNAP CAN Referral Reminder

The Policy Support Team (PST) is issuing a reminder of the process of referring NA participants to the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Career Advancement Network (SNAP CAN).

Before receiving services from SNAP CAN, NA participants must be referred to SNAP CAN by FAA. Screen NA participants and determine whether a referral to SNAP CAN is appropriate at *all* of the following:

- When an NA participant requests to participate in SNAP CAN.
- During a new NA application interview.
- During a renewal NA application interview.
- When a participant reports a change in a work registration exemption.

The NA Work Registration and SNAP CAN (FAA-1786A) Script is used to screen NA participants to determine when a referral to SNAP CAN is appropriate and to provide required referral information. The FAA-1786A form is located in the DES Document Center (Internal use only).

The Comprehensive Medical and Dental Program (CMDP) is now called the Mercy Care Department of Child Safety Comprehensive Health Plan (DCS CHP).

The change occurred due to the addition of behavioral health services to this plan.

DCS CHP provides medical services to foster care children. This program is administered by the Department of Child Safety (DCS).

FAA has the responsibility to share information with DCS CHP so that DCS can decide whether a child is eligible for foster care.
