Clarification: Timely Recert Denial and Timely Denial Date

It is not necessary to wait until the end of the business day to deny the application when the information request tenth-calendar day due date are the same as **one** of the following:

- The Timely Denial date
- The Timely Recert Denial date

When the requested information is provided, reopen the program in AZTECS. (See <u>FAA6.C02A</u> for Reopening Reasons.)

Clarification: CA New Application Timeframes

Clarification as to what happens within the 45 calendar days with a new CA application. When a denial decision is made timely, the CA application cannot be reopened.

NOTE When a CA application was denied for an incorrect reason, see <u>Reopening Reasons</u>. A new application needs to be submitted and the process starts over.

Reformat Update

The CNAP Manual is going through a reformatting project to complete *all* of the following:

- Change the look and feel by moving the Table of Contents out of an AZTECS roadmap flow.
- Reduce the number of references to make it easier to find what is needed.
