CSED summarizes and displays Four-Month Continued Coverage ELIGIBILITY FACTORS from prior AZTECS screens.

Authorize the Four-Month Continued Coverage eligibility determination on MADA. (See <u>AZTECS TMA and Four-Month Continued Coverage</u> <u>Procedures</u>)

02 Four-Month Continued Coverage - Overview

For MA after 2013 See the EPM

1931 participants who become ineligible due to receipt of child support income may receive up to four consecutive months of medical coverage.

> To be eligible to receive Four-Month Continued Coverage MA, ALL of the following must apply to the participant:

 Was eligible for and received 1931 MA in Arizona for at least THREE out of the SIX months prior to the first 1931 ineligible month.

- Was eligible for and received 1931 MA in Arizona in the MONTH prior to the first month of Four-Month Continued Coverage.
- 1931 MA ineligibility resulted from receipt of child or spousal support by a participant in the budgetary unit.
- Be a resident of Arizona.
- Have a dependent child in the home.
- Continue to cooperate with DCSS Medical Support and Third Party Liability (TPL) requirements.

B Four-Month Continued Coverage - Reporting Requirements

For MA after 2013 See the EPM

Participants who are eligible for Four-Month Continued Coverage are required to report <u>changes</u> that affect eligibility.

Determine whether participants remain eligible for the Four-Month Continued Coverage, when a change is reported for any of the following:

- Adding Participants to Four-Month Continued Coverage
- Removing Participants from Four-Month Continued Coverage

.01 Adding Participants to Four-Month Continued Coverage

For MA after 2013 See the EPM

Someone may move into the home during the Four-Month Continued Coverage period. When this occurs, determine whether the participant was included in the <u>1931 budgetary unit</u> at the time of 1931 closure.

When YES, verify all required eligibility factors to add the applicant and add the applicant when verification has been provided.

When NO, determine whether eligibility exists for the applicant in any MA category.

.02 Removing Participants from Four-Month Continued Coverage

For MA after 2013 See the EPM

Complete the following when it is reported that a participant moved out of the home during the Four-Month Continued Coverage period:

- Remove the participant from the case when there are other participants in the case who remain eligible. (See NOAA)
- Authorize continued eligibility for remaining participants on MADA.

NOTE For Four-Month Continued Coverage eligibility to continue, a dependent child must reside in the home.

 Send the <u>M200 notice</u> to inform the PI of the participant's stopped coverage.

03 Stopping Four-Month Continued Coverage - Overview

For MA after 2013 See the EPM

Four-Month Continued Coverage can only be stopped for the following reasons:

- Loss of residency
- Medical support noncooperation
- No dependent child

(See <u>Renewal - All FAIL</u> for keying procedures to stop Four-Month Continued Coverage)

To stop Four-Month Continued Coverage, complete the following:

- Close the Four-Month Continued Coverage case. (See <u>MA Ineligible</u> Date begin date exceptions for keying procedures)
- Send the M200 notice to advise the PI of case closure.

(See <u>Eligibility for Remaining Balance of Four-Month Continued Coverage</u> at new application)

04 Eligibility for Remaining Balance of Four-Month Continued Coverage

For MA after 2013 See the EPM

AZTECS tracks the Four-Month Continued Coverage period. When participants reapply for MA, AZTECS determines whether a balance is remaining in the four-month period.

Participants are eligible to receive any remaining balance of the original Four-Month Continued Coverage period when all of the following are met:

- They reapply for MA and are determined to be ineligible in the 1931 MA category.
- Arizona residency requirements continue to be met.
- A dependent child who was an eligible participant in the last month of 1931 eligibility resides in the home.

When ALL applicants are determined to be ineligible for the remaining balance of the Four-Month Continued Coverage period, AZTECS displays on MADA the determination RESULT for the last MA category tested.

When eligibility exists in another category, authorize the determination on MADA.
